Success rate in undergraduate programmes	<b>69.8%</b> in 2004	<b>77.8%</b> in 2014	<b>≥80%</b>
1 <sup>st</sup> year dropout rate for undergraduate programmes	<b>31.5%</b> in 2000	<b>19.1%</b> in 2012	<b>15%?</b>
Cohort throughput rate for undergraduate contact programmes ( <u>after year 6</u> )	<b>49.3%</b> (2000)	<b>61.4%</b> (2008)	<b>75%?</b>
Cohort throughput rate for undergraduate distance programmes ( <u>after year 10</u> )	<b>11.6%</b> (2000)	<b>14.8%</b> (2006)	<b>?</b>

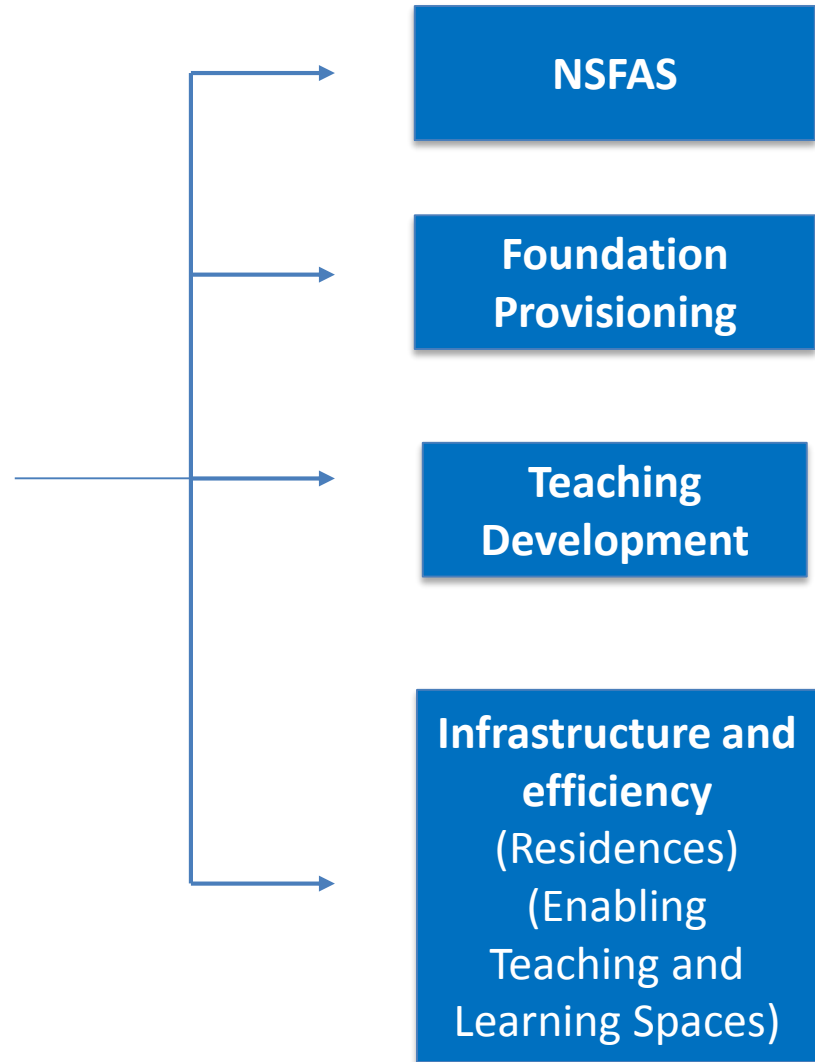

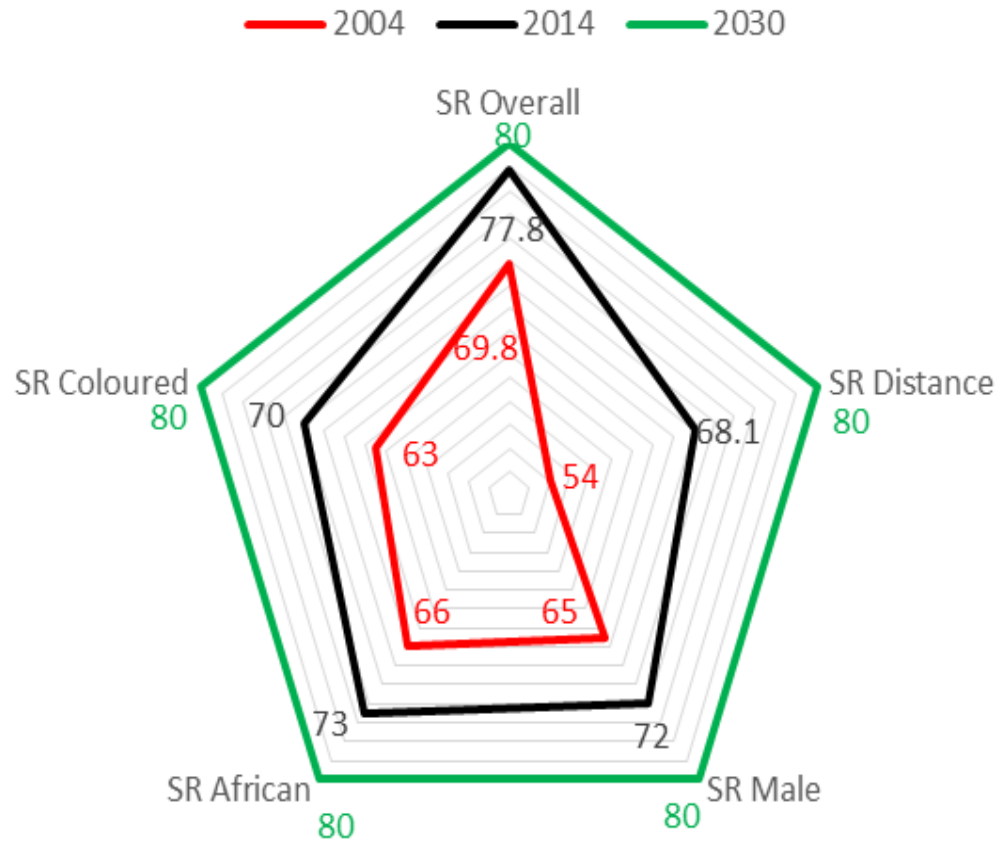

## Success rate in undergraduate programmes



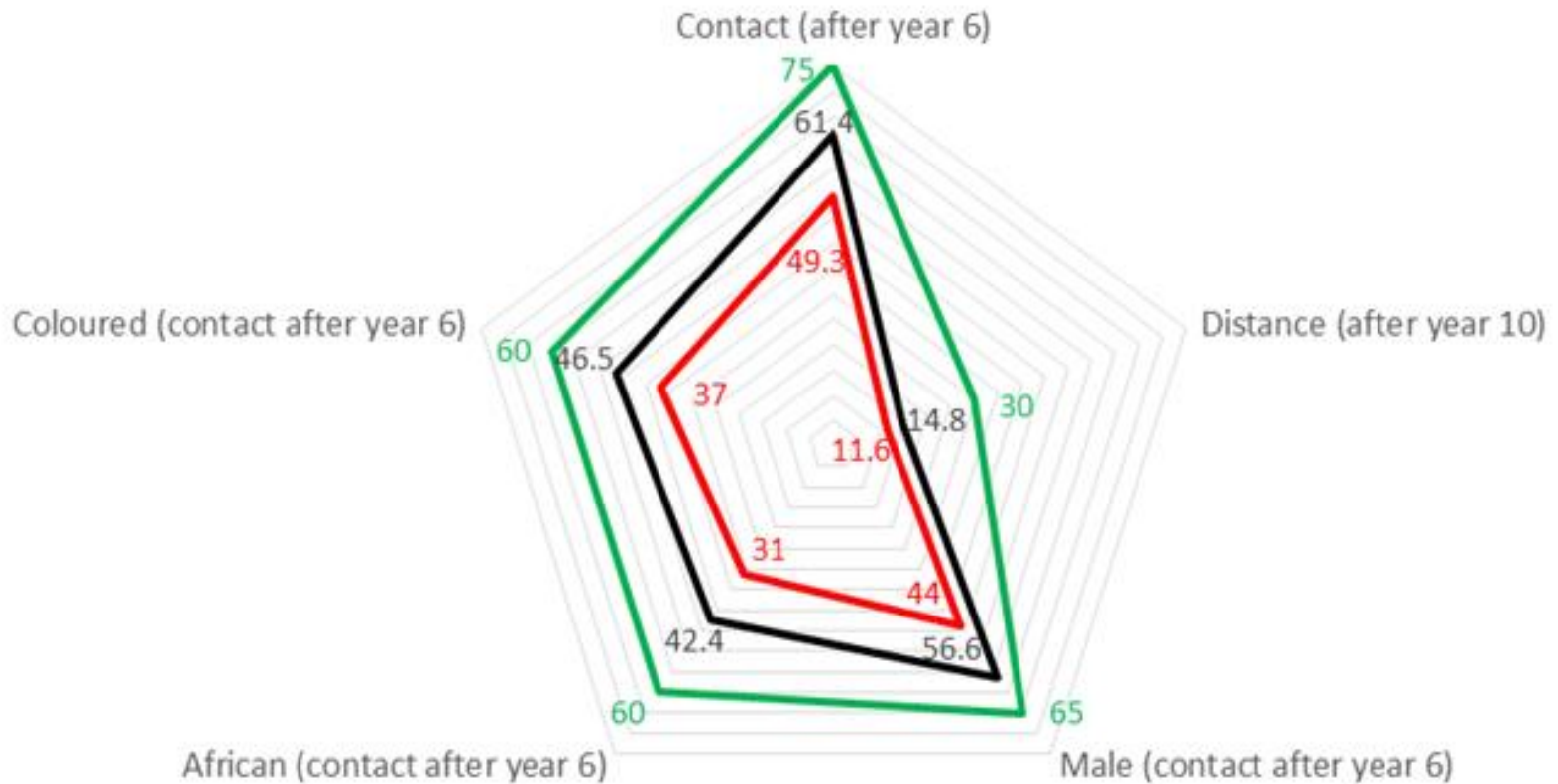

— 2008(c)/ 2005(d)

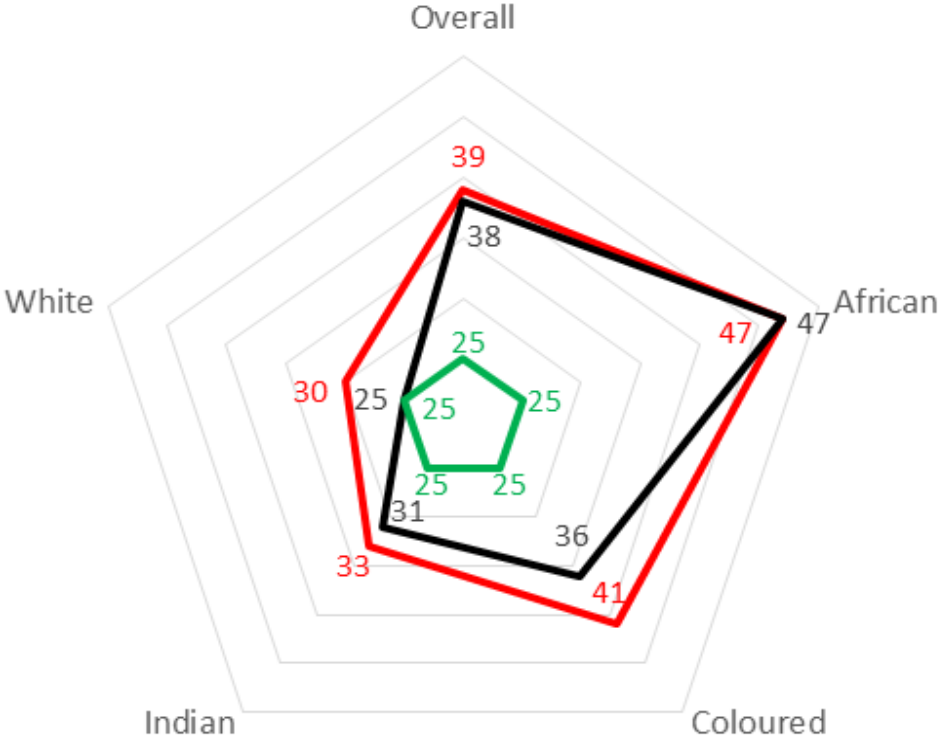

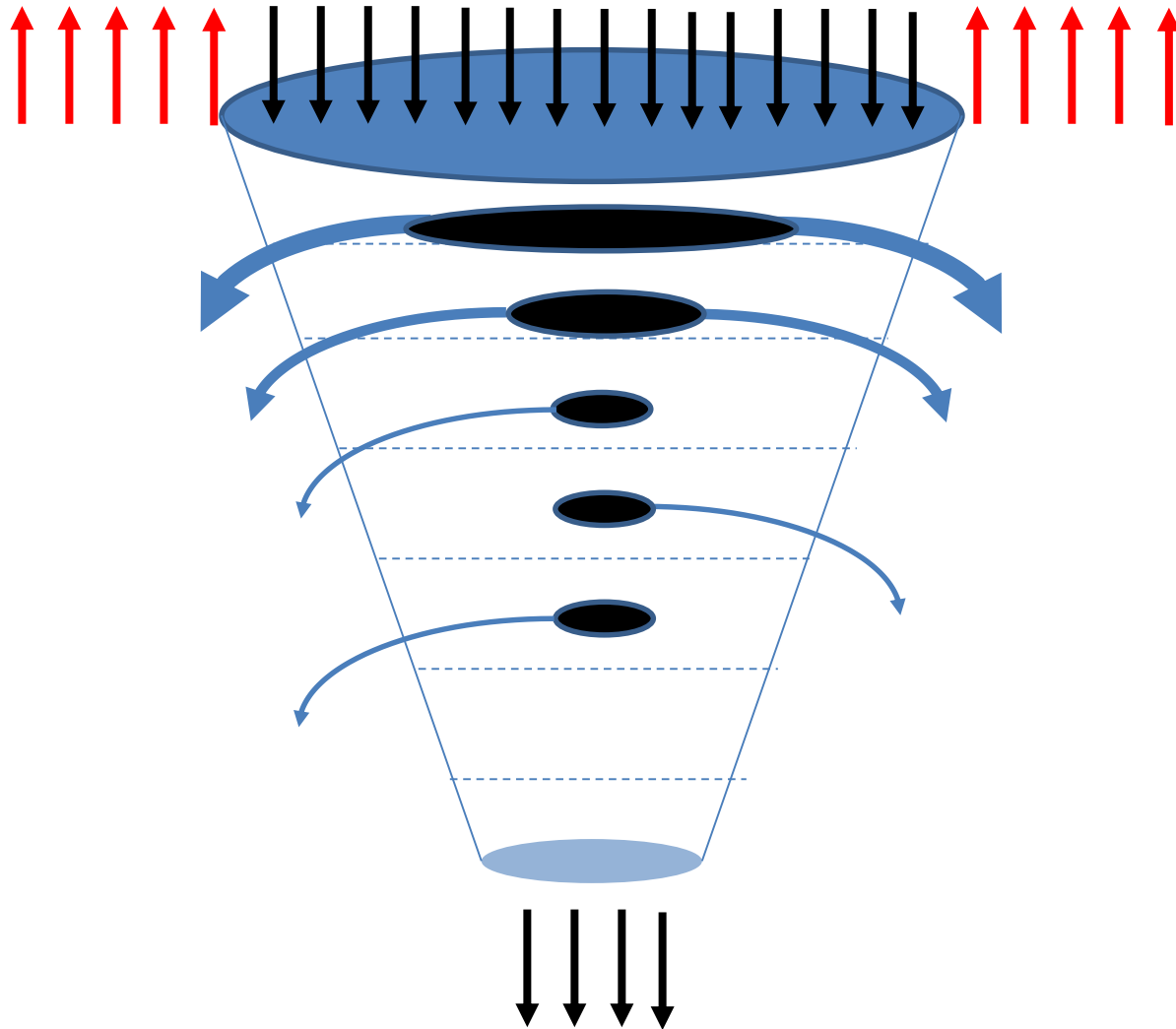
## Dropout rate for coursework masters at universities

— 2008 cohort      — 2009 cohort      — 2025 (2020 cohort)



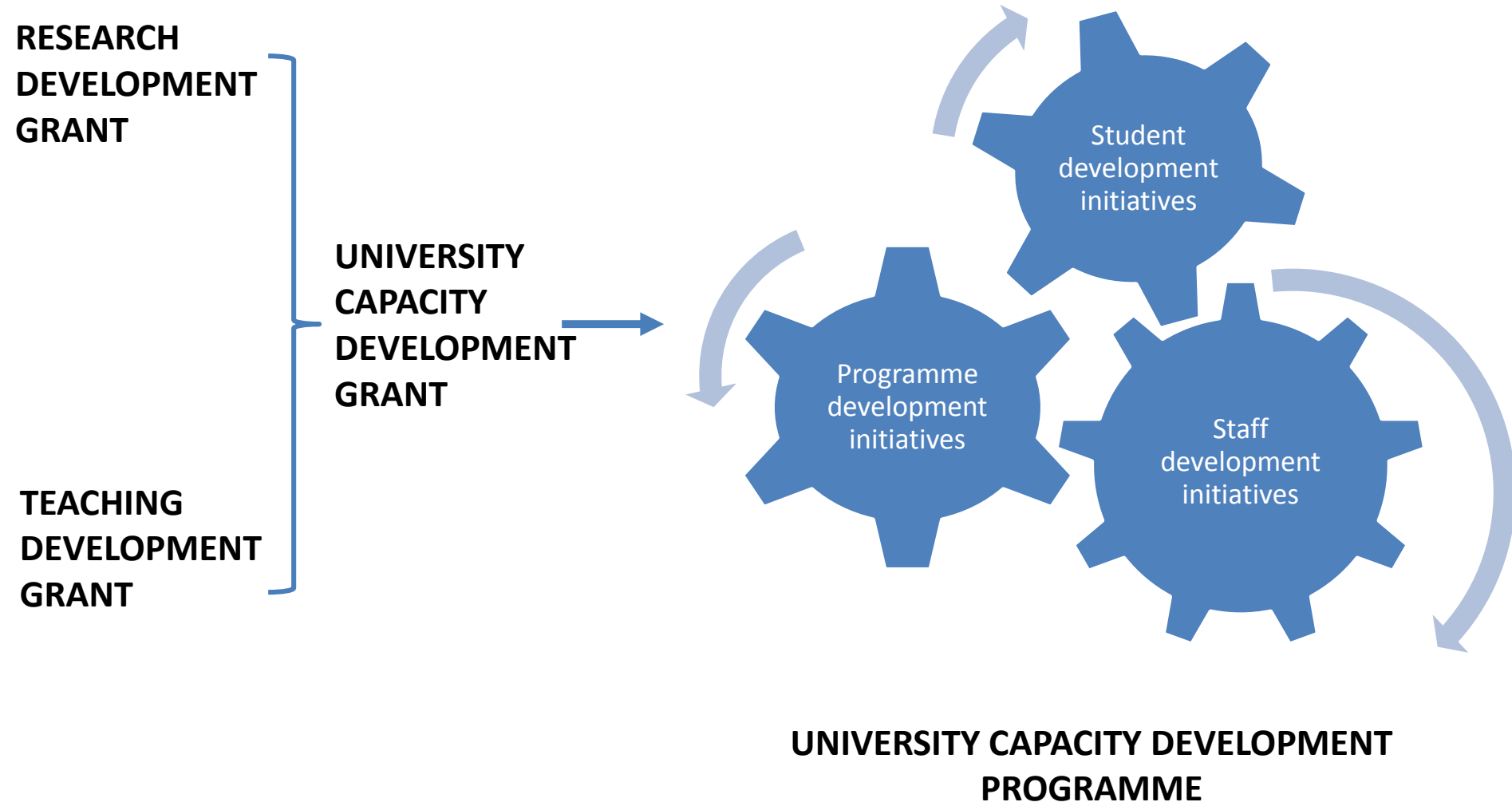

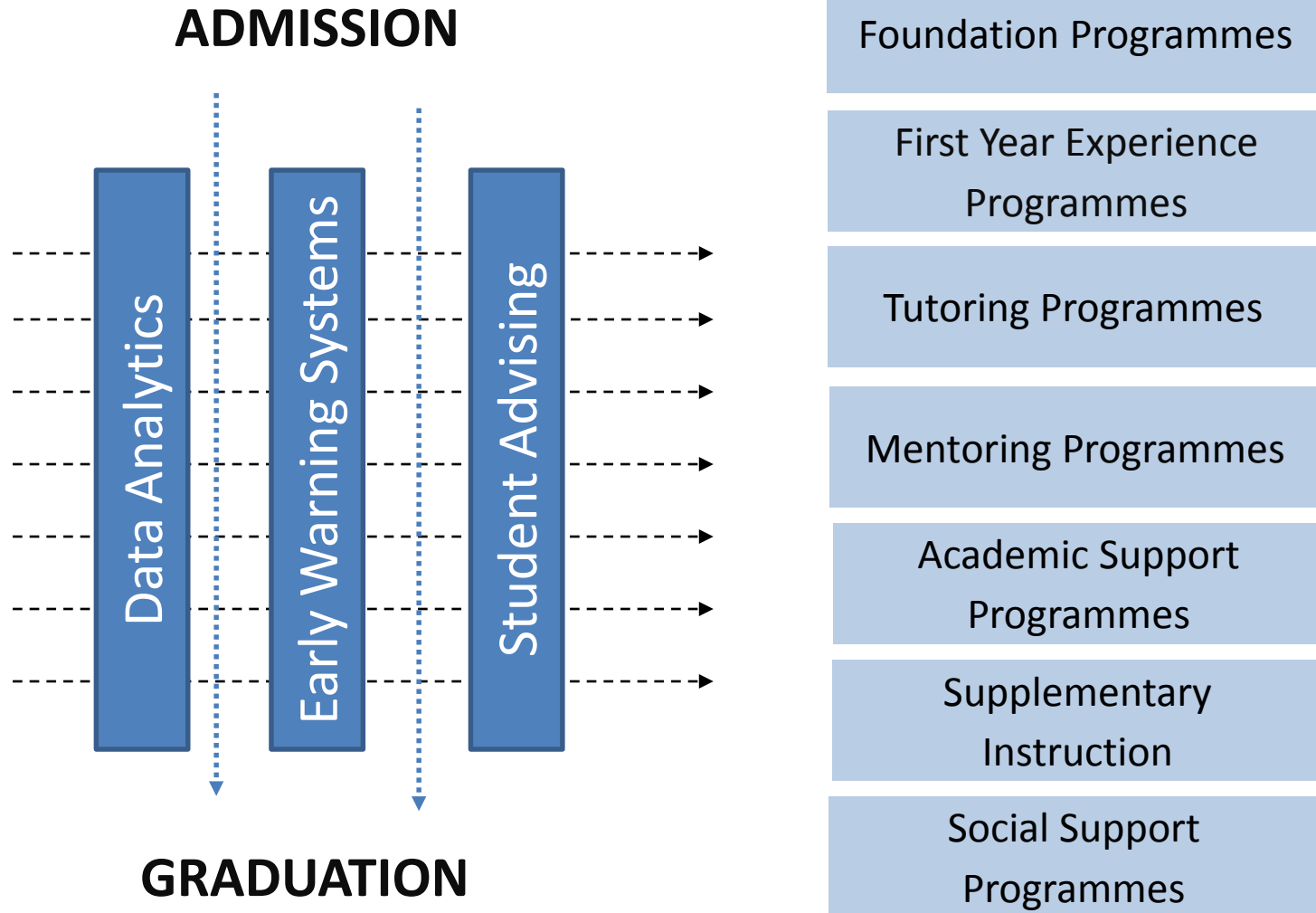

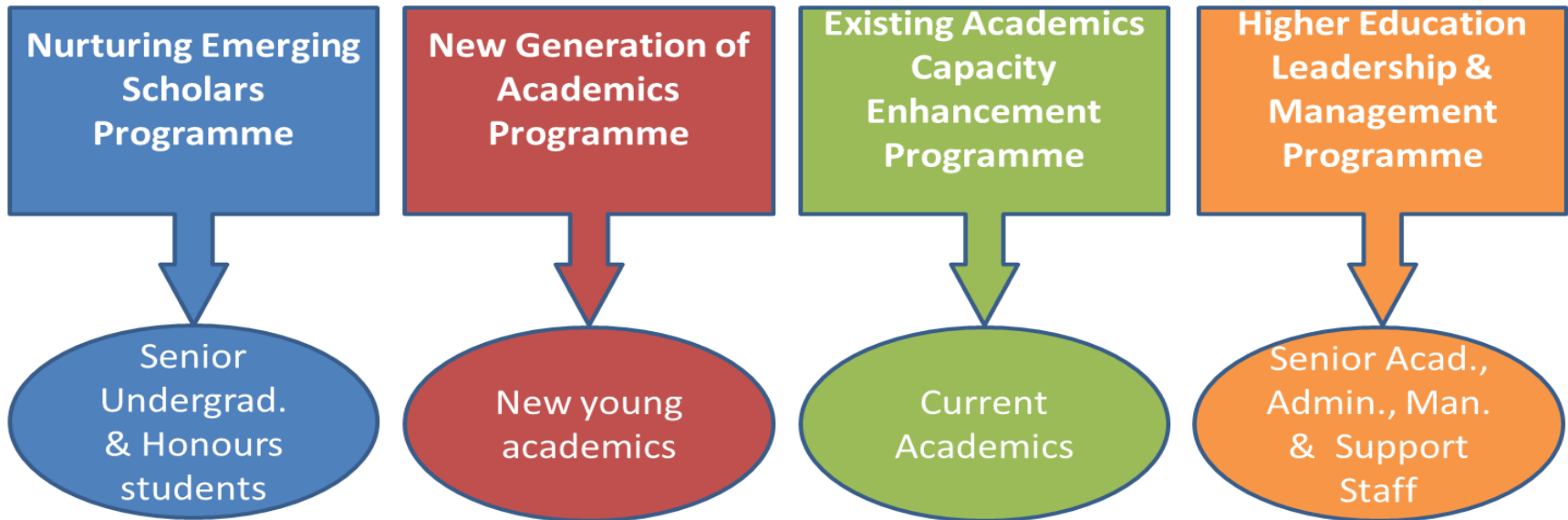

Supplementary Staff Programme

Will enable universities to recruit, in a temporary capacity, people with specific skills to support the implementation of other SSAUF programmes, for example retired academics, experts in industry, professionals and contracted academics from other countries

Cuts across the core programmes and supports teaching and research development needs in each programme.
